

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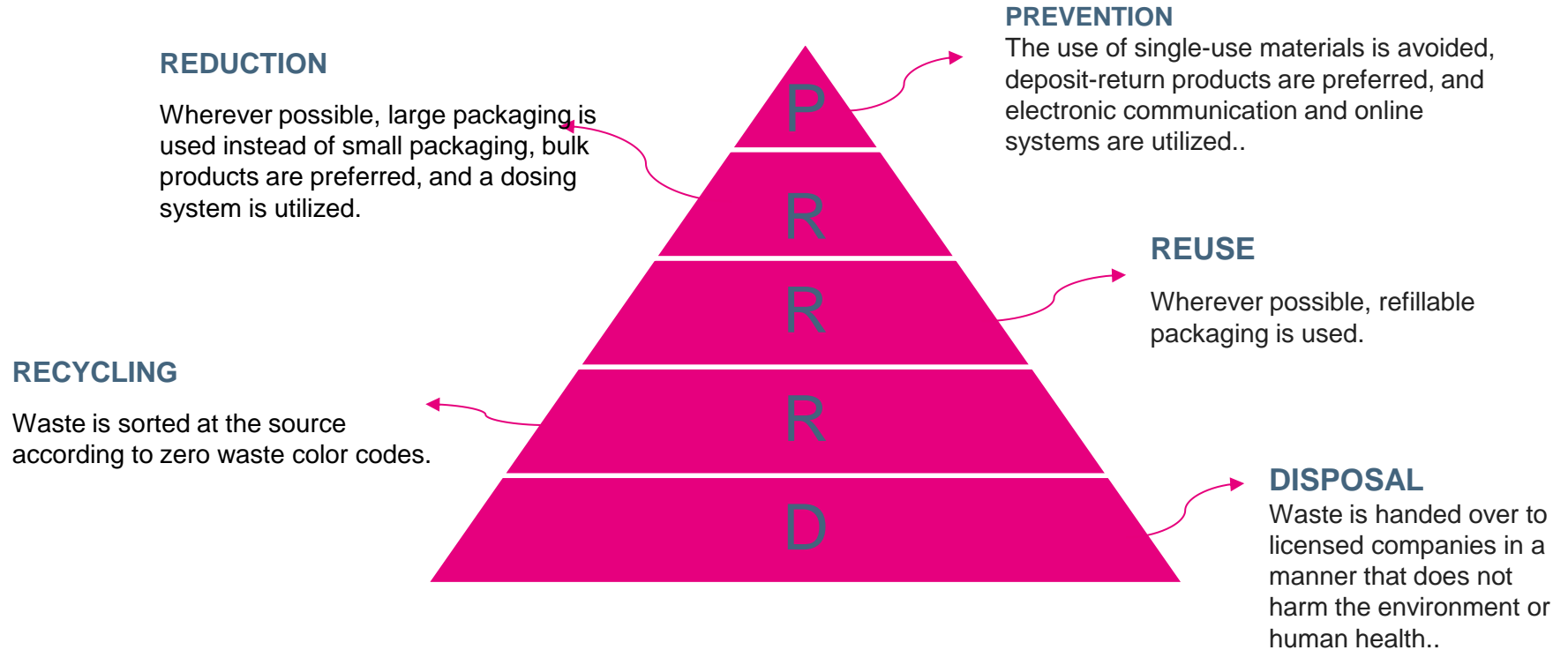
WASTE MANAGEMENT

Our Waste Management Practices

- Our staff receives ongoing training on waste awareness.
- We collaborate with Didim Municipality's "Can Dostlar İçin Mama Fabrikası" (Food Factory for Animal Friends) to send organic waste generated at our facility to the factory under the zero waste slogan for animal feed.
- To reduce plastic waste, we primarily use large-volume water containers at our facility. In areas where small packaged water is necessary, we prefer glass bottles.
- Recycling bins are available in all areas, and we encourage our employees and guests to participate in recycling.
- We use environmentally friendly hotel key cards, eliminating the use of PVC with sustainable key cards.
- We implement sustainable menu practices, creating QR codes in service areas that allow our guests to manage food and beverage orders, thereby reducing waste consumption.
- Products such as shampoo and shower gel in rooms are chosen in large packaging to minimize waste.
- We aim to prevent plastic use by using paper straws.



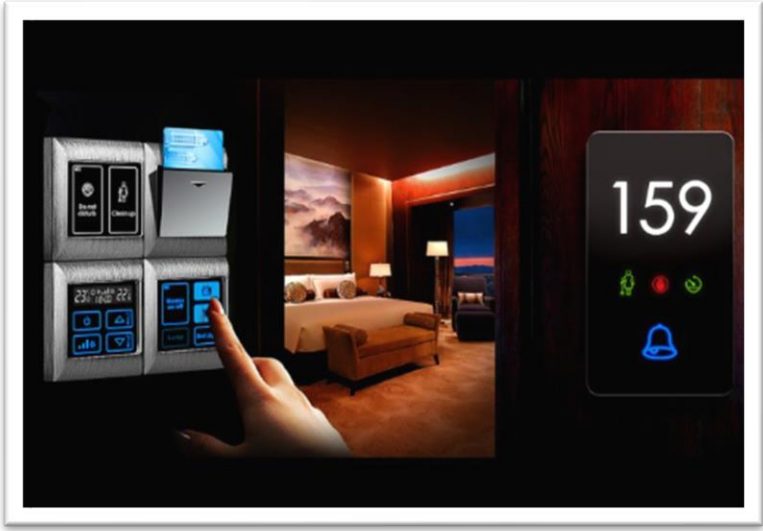
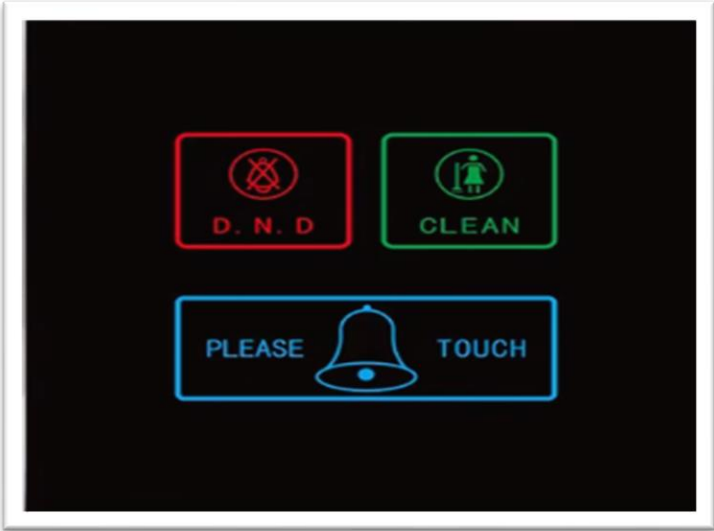

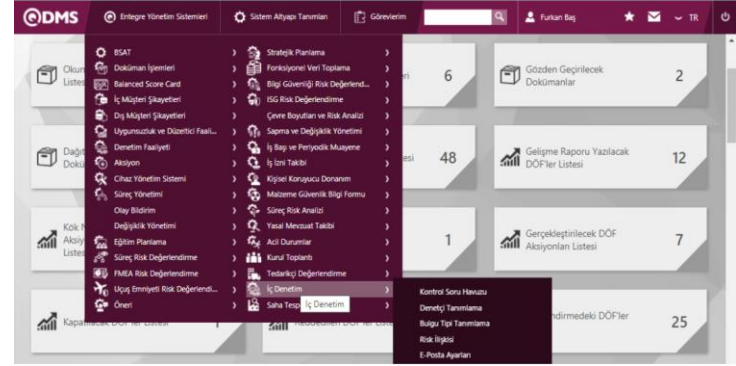

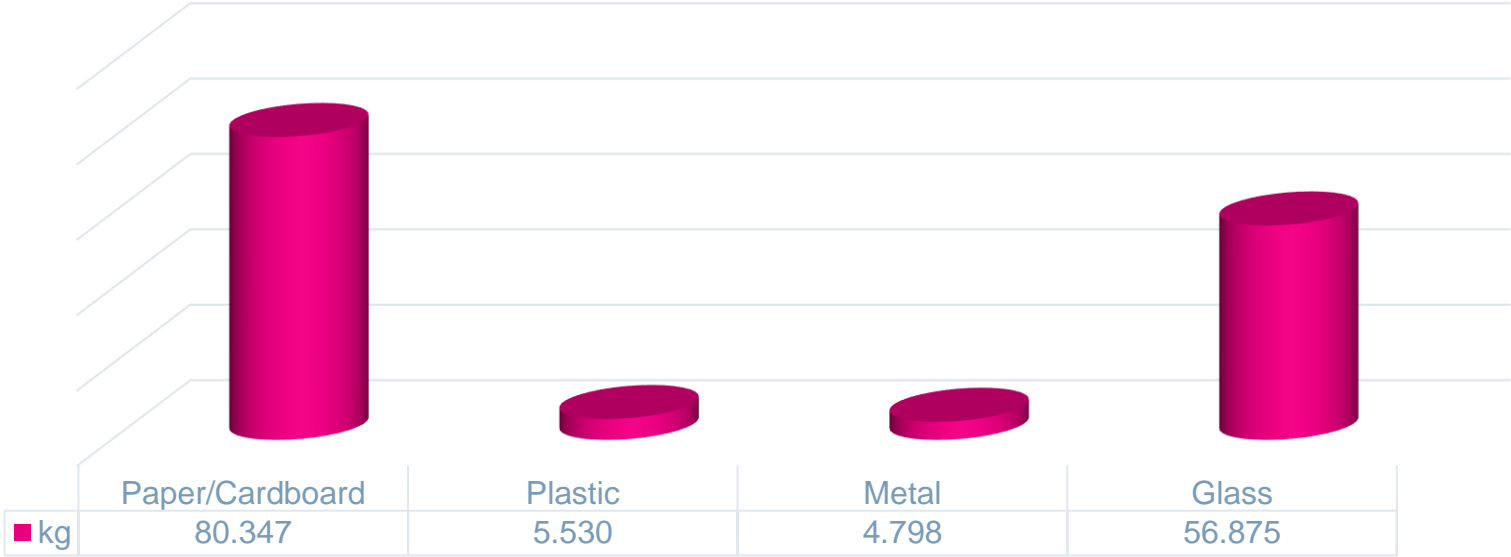

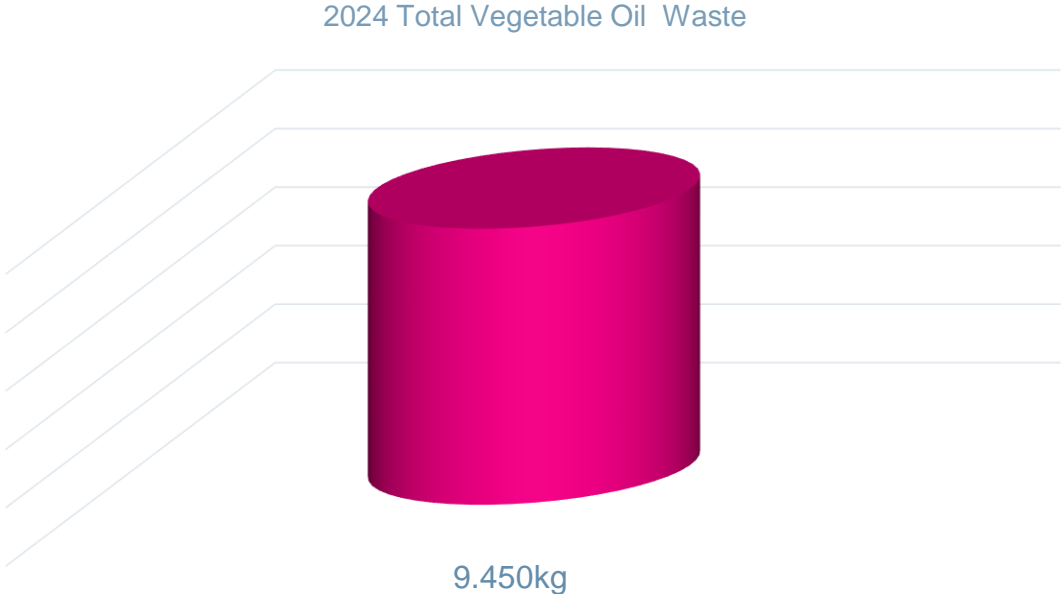

OUR WASTE SEPARATIONS

In our facility, a special temporary waste storage area has been created to ensure the safe and organized storage of waste. In this area, there are different storage units separated according to the types of waste:

- Two cold rooms are used to prevent the decomposition of organic waste and to ensure safe storage for health reasons. For hazardous waste, vegetable oil waste, and glass waste, there are rooms designed specifically for each type.
- These rooms ensure the safe storage of waste without harming the environment. Separate containers have been placed for recyclable waste (paper, plastic, metal).
- This facilitates the recycling of these materials and reduces their environmental impact.

This waste storage system adopts an environmentally friendly approach, aiming to both optimize waste management and increase recycling rates.



ENERGY MANAGEMENT

Our Energy Management Practices

- In the context of a green building, sustainable material selection was prioritized during the construction phase of our facility, and 20% of the building structure is made from stones sourced from the site. Insulation has been used in all of our buildings.
- In this context, factors such as resource efficiency, environmental impact, and indoor air quality have been addressed.
- We have rooftop gardens for a green atmosphere, and we strive to balance our carbon footprint.
- Smart building technologies have been implemented. Our rooms are equipped with air conditioning and occupancy sensors, enabling energy management. A digital DND (Do Not Disturb) system is used, and waste production has been minimized.
- To reduce our carbon footprint, the pools in our facility are heated with heat pumps, contributing to energy conservation.
- We provide bicycles in guest areas, helping to reduce our carbon footprint. Our facility uses 100% LED lighting, which allows us to consume less energy.
- We have two electric vehicle charging stations in our facility, encouraging both guests and employees to reduce their environmental impact.

Energy Sources

Anda Barut Collection is a high-capacity facility where a variety of energy sources and technologies are used together. Energy data is recorded through various methods and is regularly reported. It is monitored through operational and financial analyses. The lighting, climate control, irrigation, and other automation systems in use create opportunities for savings. By sourcing efficient, cost-saving, environmentally friendly, and new technology products, the goal is to have a positive impact on energy values.

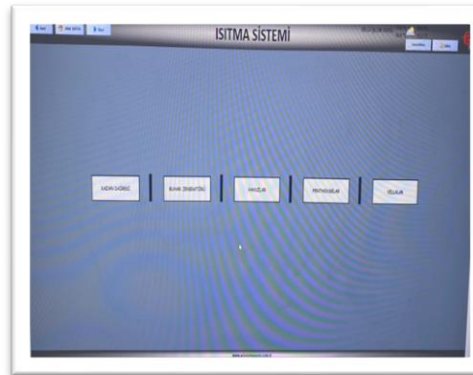
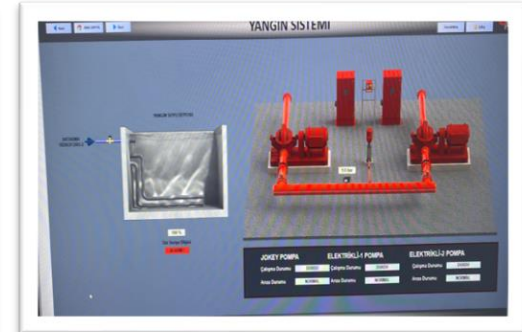
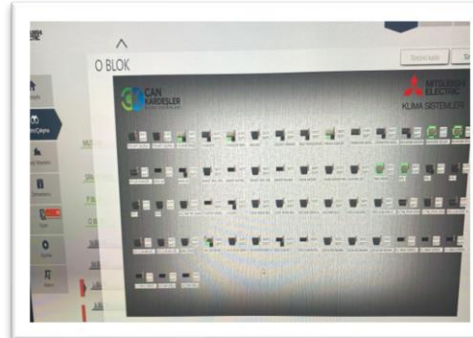

Automation Systems

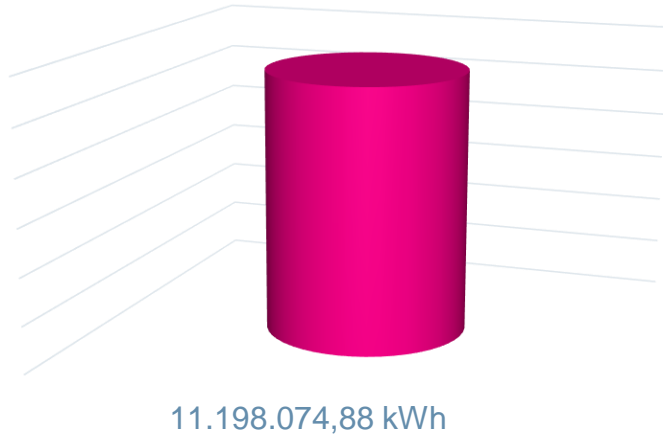
In our facility, automation systems are used to ensure effective management and control in various areas. **Climate Control Systems:** Automation solutions that optimize indoor temperature and humidity levels. **Pool Water Management:** Regular monitoring and control of the quality and temperature of pool water. **Garden Irrigation:** Garden irrigation processes are automatically controlled to prevent water waste. **Fire Detection and Suppression Systems:** Automation systems are used for early detection and quick intervention to ensure fire safety. **Cold Storage:** Monitoring the temperature and humidity levels in cold storage areas and making automatic adjustments when necessary. These automation systems play a crucial role in increasing the facility's efficiency and ensuring energy savings.

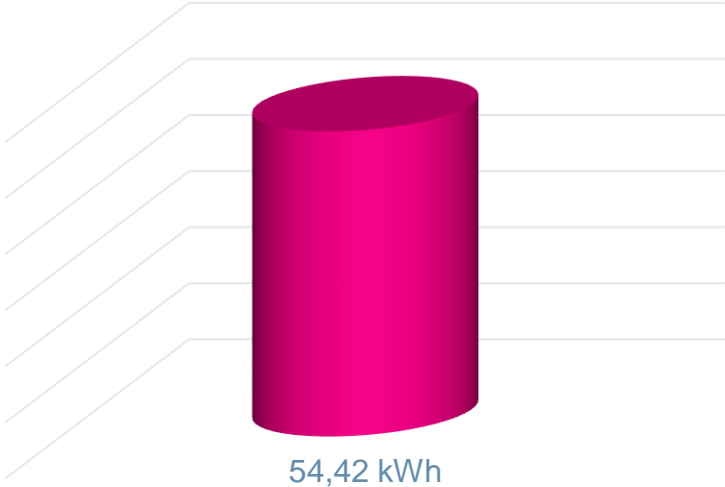

WATER MANAGEMENT

Our Water Management Practices

- Our facility is equipped with a reverse osmosis system. Seawater is used to produce utility water, minimizing the need for freshwater resources.
- We conduct domestic wastewater recycling in our facility. The wastewater is treated in our biological treatment plant and used for garden irrigation, reducing our dependence on water resources.
- In plant selection, we have chosen approximately 85% drought-resistant plants, reducing water consumption.
- We use water-efficient technologies. In garden irrigation, sprinkler and drip systems are used to ensure water is used consciously.
- We use environmentally friendly smart planters, which help prevent unnecessary water consumption and contribute to water savings.
- We are developing water management plans to reduce water consumption. For water-efficient usage, washing machines and dishwashers are used for full-load cycles.
- Rainwater harvesting is implemented in our facility. By collecting rainwater, we aim to reduce our dependence on water resources for irrigation.
- We offer guests the option to reuse their bed linens, contributing to water savings.
- Sensor faucets are used in public areas, helping to reduce water consumption.

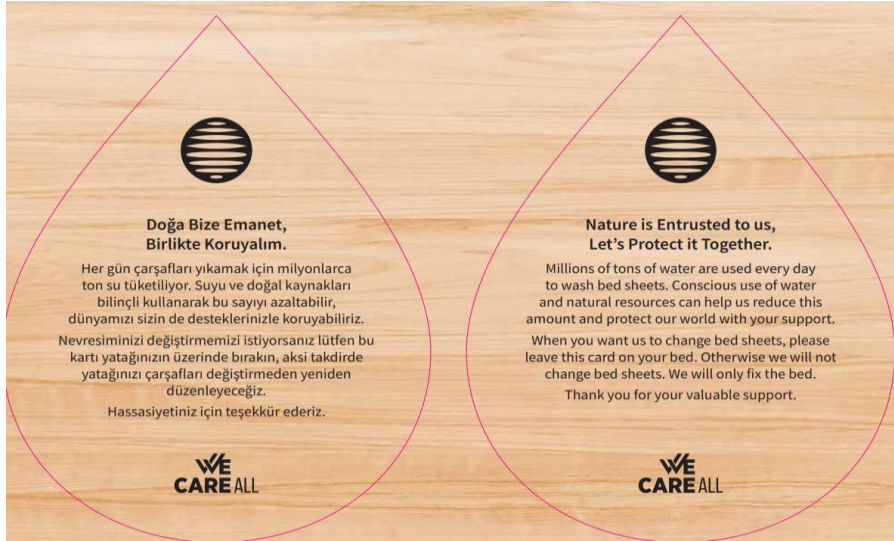
The irrigation of green areas throughout the facility is carried out with timer-controlled automation programs. This ensures that water resources are used correctly, preventing excessive use.

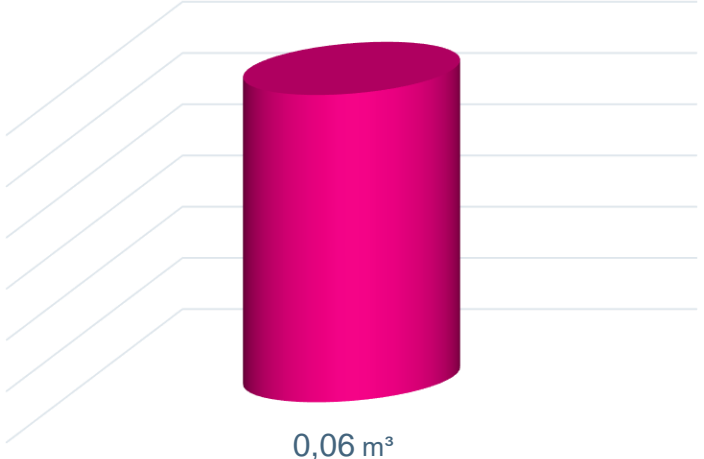

Our Projects Related to Chemical Usage

Anda Barut Collection Hotel places great importance on sustainability practices regarding chemical usage. Focused on protecting both the health of its guests and the environment, the hotel is committed to the conscious use of chemicals. Environmentally friendly and health-conscious cleaning products are preferred in the selection of cleaning agents.

Our Applications Related to Chemical Usage:

Chemical Consumption Monitoring: We regularly track our daily chemical consumption to reduce chemical usage.

Concentrated Products for Room Cleaning: For room cleaning, we prefer concentrated cleaning products to support environmentally friendly and efficient use, and we use a dosing system.

Shampoo and Soap Usage: In guest rooms, the use of liquid shampoo and soap is being increased instead of single-use products.

Guest Amenities and Packaging Waste: We aim to minimize the use of guest amenities and the packaging waste generated by these items in guest rooms.

Pool Chemical Management: In our pools, automatic chemical dosing systems are used to ensure hygienic practices are applied correctly and effectively.

Pest Control Safety: We meticulously check the chemicals used by the external pest control company to ensure they are non-harmful to human health and the environment.

Chemical Waste Management: We work with authorized firms to safely dispose of chemicals and track the disposal of chemical waste.



CHEMICAL MANAGEMENT

Automation Systems

The chemicals used in **the Pool Water, Laundry, F&B, and Stewarding areas** are applied in a controlled manner through automatic dosing systems. With this system, the chemical consumption of each unit can be monitored and optimized.

With 14 bicycles available for use in guest areas, we offer an eco-friendly mode of transportation and provide guests with the opportunity to explore the hotel. Cycling also promotes physical activity, contributing to health and fitness. Using bicycles at our facility brings both fun and a sustainable accommodation experience.

Anda Barut Collection, with the support of female chefs and female staff, demonstrates a commitment to gender equality in the tourism industry. With a total of 896 employees, Anda Barut Collection has 291 female staff members. In the kitchen team, there are 171 people, 46 of whom are women. The main goal is to achieve gender balance in all departments, with an initial aim of reaching a 40% female - 60% male workforce at Anda Barut Collection.

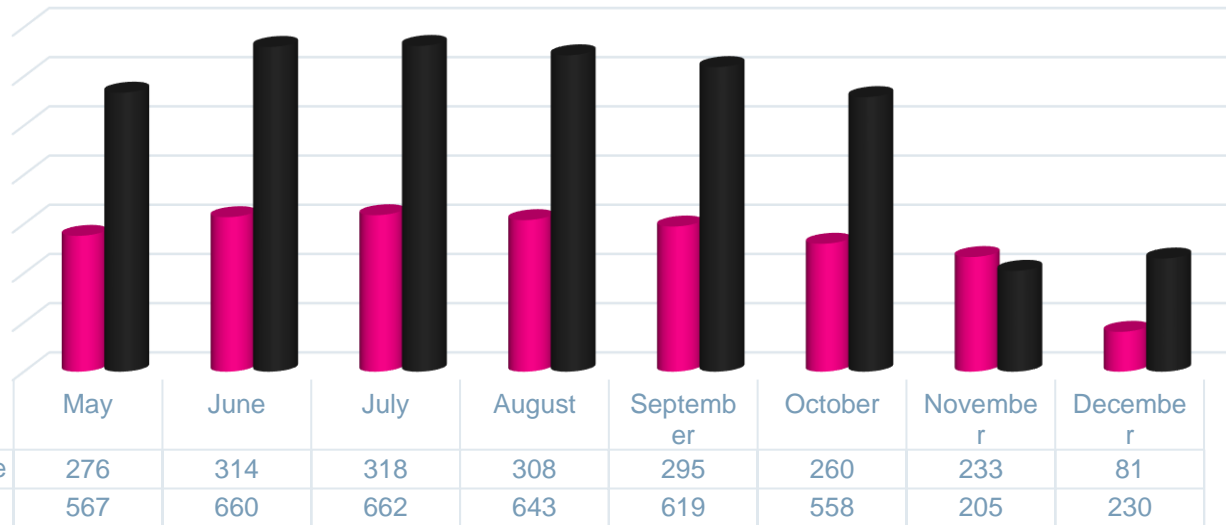

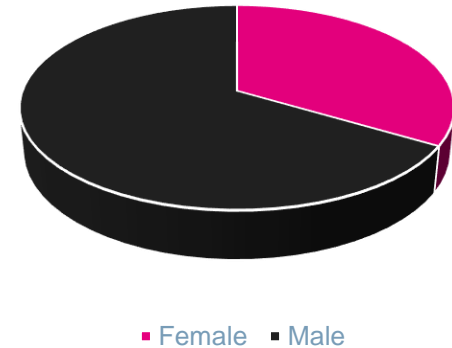

2024 Female-Male Number of Employees



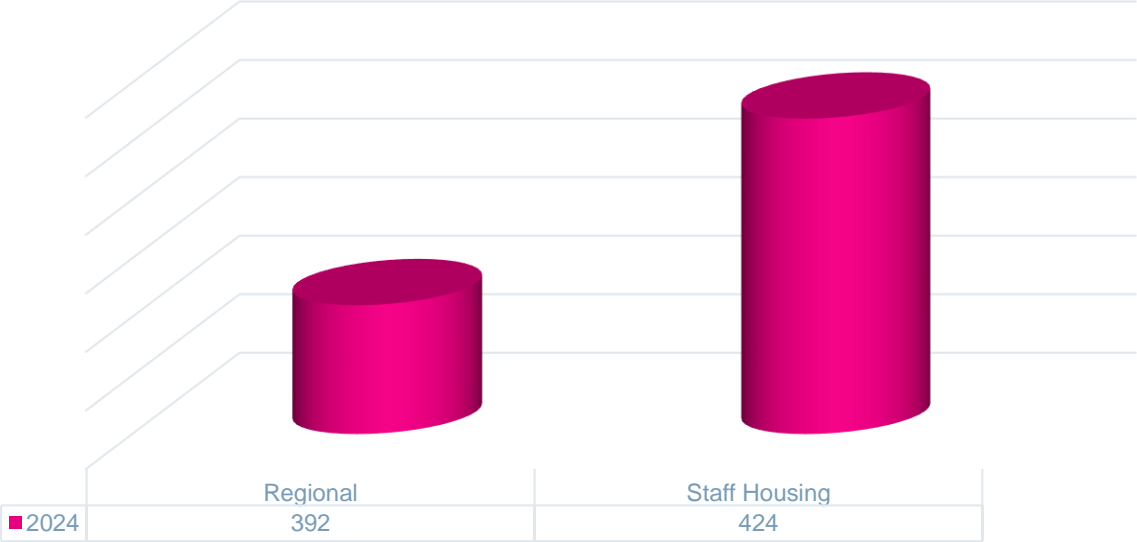
2024 Average Female-Male Number of Employees

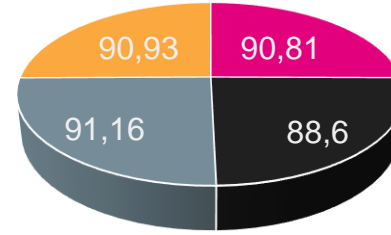

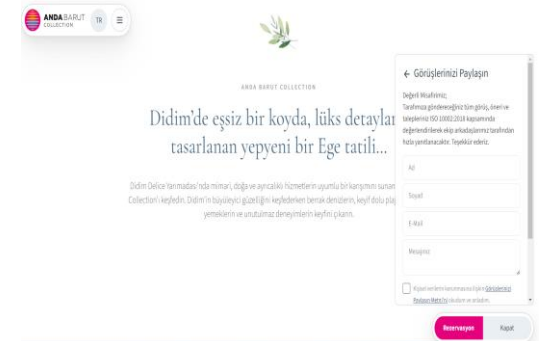

Accessible Vacation

Our accessible pool lifts are wheelchair-friendly, providing easy access to the pool at any desired location. The wheels rotate in all directions, have a brake system, and the tires are fixed with a high stabilization system, preventing any risk of slipping during lowering or lifting. Safety is a priority for us, with seat belts and non-slip seating surfaces ensuring security. Our pool lifts are designed ergonomically, ensuring comfort and ease of use for our guests. The simple control system allows guests to use the lift comfortably without needing a second person. Additionally, the lift distance, pool depth, and the system are adjustable to suit individual needs. Floating loungers allow easy access to the sea for physically disabled and elderly guests who have difficulty walking. We aim to support disabled guests in overcoming their disadvantageous situation, ensuring they are not excluded and can develop both personally and socially within the community. Furthermore, this season, we will introduce an emergency button for hearing-impaired guests to use during sea activities. The device is practical, with a small button worn around the neck that sends a signal in case of an emergency, alerting the lifeguard's wristband and protecting the guest from potential dangers.




Water and Wastewater Management

In our facility, both tap water and reverse osmosis water are used, and there is an active and monitored conditioning system in place. The water distributed throughout the facility from our water lines is of drinking water quality and is monitored through daily, weekly, and monthly measurements and analyses. Water consumption in the system is recorded through meters and processed into consumption reports.

Additionally, wastewater in our facility is converted into irrigation water for the gardens using a treatment system.



62,110 m³ of Domestic Wastewater was used for garden irrigation.



149,524.3 m³ of tap water usage was avoided thanks to reverse osmosis.

Electric Vehicles and Charging Facilities

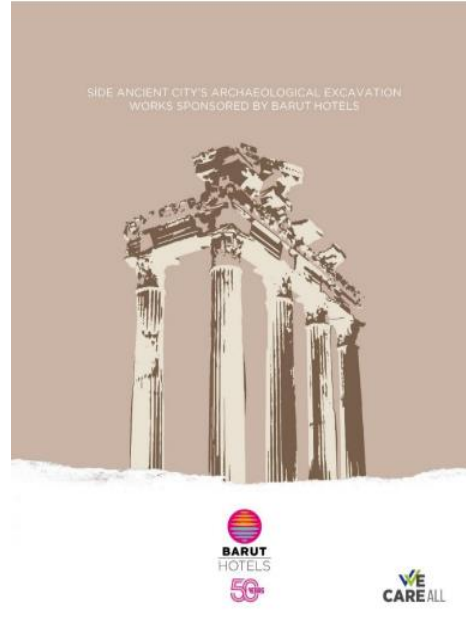

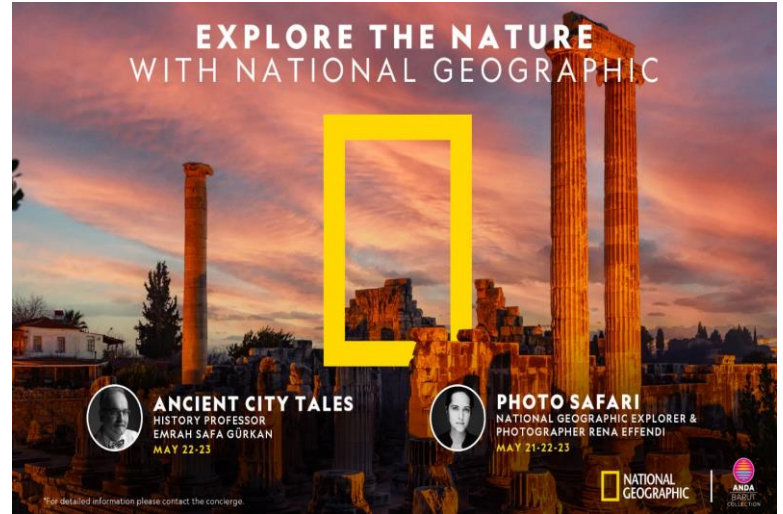
